Evaluation: The evaluation refers to the condition of the offer within the test period. Changes made after the end of the test were not taken into account. During the test period, an iterative consultation process took place, which successively pointed out problematic areas in the tool in exemplary form, whereupon these were rectified. Essentially, these were deficiencies in the keyboard operation, the contrast display, the display of elements with individual settings of the foreground and background, the usability with different screen sizes, the sequence with keyboard operation, overlaps of informative areas by tool tips or subwindows as well as smaller semantic irregularities. Eye-Able® is a browser plugin explicitly designed for use by people with visual impairments, which can be installed server-side or as a browser plugin. The integrated speech output function can additionally be used by people with cognitive impairments, although it is to be expected that this group, like blind people, will usually already have installed assistive devices. Contrast, keyboard usability, focus highlighting, usability with the screen reader as well as usability with enlarged display, to name just a few aspects, have been implemented in compliance with WCAG.

Result:

After a thorough examination, the application can be described as WCAG-compliant.
